

Travelers' Century Club

Membership in the Travelers' Century Club is limited to those who

have visited one hundred or more countries and island groups of the world. It was first organized in Los Angeles in 1957, by a group of the world's most widely-traveled people. The idea has attracted the interest of world travelers everywhere. We now have members throughout the United States, as well as in many foreign countries.

The motto of the Century Club is — "World Travel ... the Passport to Peace through Understanding." In this connection we quote from a talk made at the World Travel Congress in 1958 by Mr. E. C. Daniels, Assistant Managing Editor of the New York Times as follows:

"If there is left in the world any hope whatsoever that men can live in peace, despite the terrible weapons they have created to destroy each other, that hope lies in a better understanding among peoples. Understanding isn't possible without extensive personal contacts. Personal contact can only be made by traveling. As the late Pope Pius said, 'Away with the barriers, break down the barbed wire fences, let people be free to know the life of other people, let that segregation of some countries from the rest of the world — so dangerous to peace — be abolished."

If you can qualify, you are invited to become a member. Originally it was intended that there should be no dues, but as the Club has grown there have been inevitable expenses — the printing of brochures, rosters, stationery, postage, and secretarial help. The majority of the members therefore agreed on an Initiation Fee of \$25.00, plus yearly dues of \$10.00.

Shown here is the Club's official list of countries and island groups — a total of 254, as of November 1, 1965, Although some are not actually countries in their own right, they have been included because they are removed from parent countries, either geographically, politically or ethnologically. After consideration as to how long one must have stayed in a country or island group to qualify, it was decided that even the shortest of visits would suffice - even if only a portof-call, or a plane fuel stop. This, and our liberal membership requirements, greatly widens the field and will give you a better chance to qualify for one of the most unusual clubs in the world, and certainly the most exclusive travel group.

If you are eligible, please submit a list of countries you have visited. When this information has been received and approved, with payment of initiation fee and current year's dues, you will be forwarded your membership card. Needless to say, your travel agent will be glad to assist you with any additional travel you may need for qualification.
