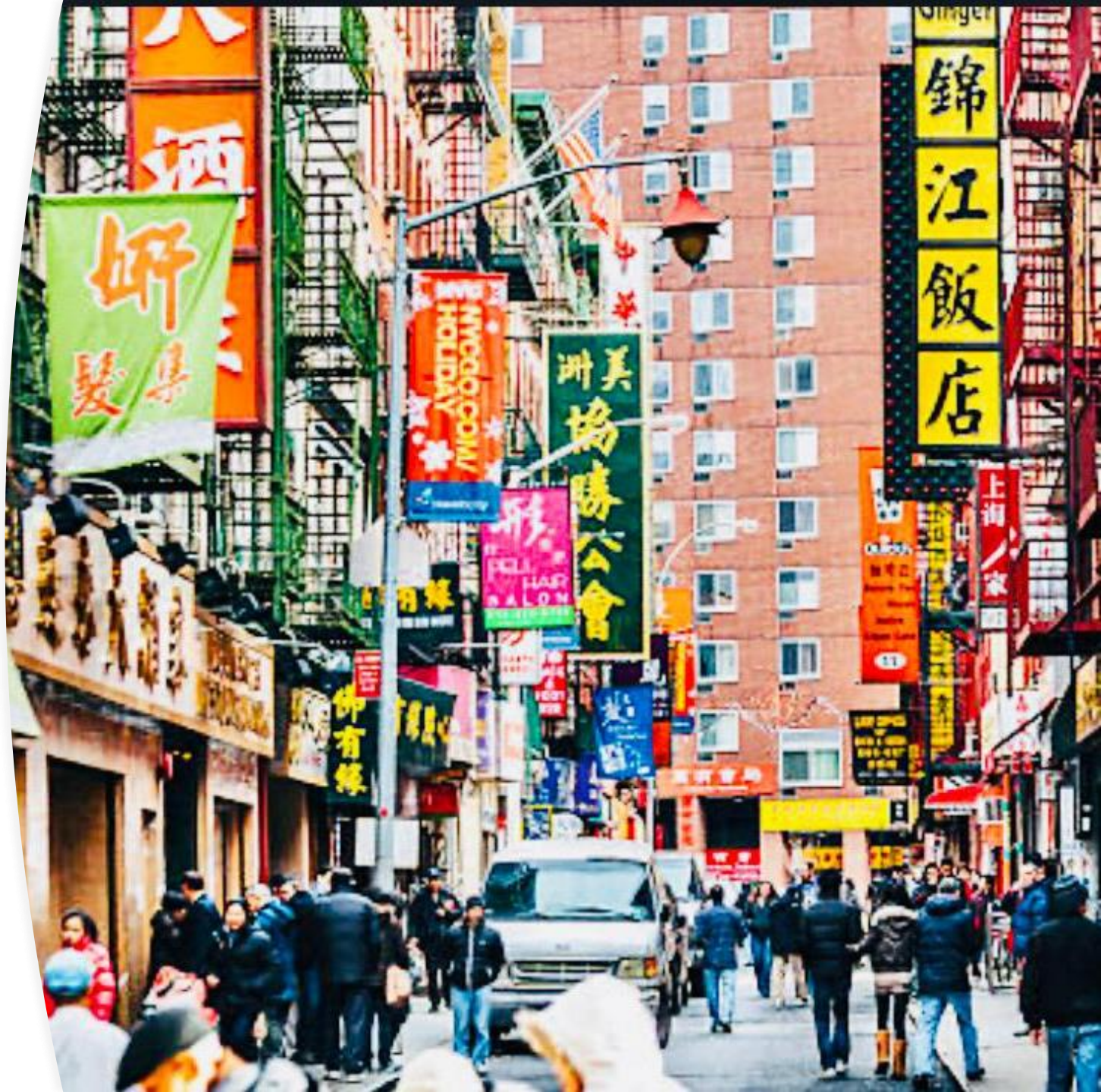

- The Africa Center with Sherri Donovan. Leading art and cultural center for the Continent.





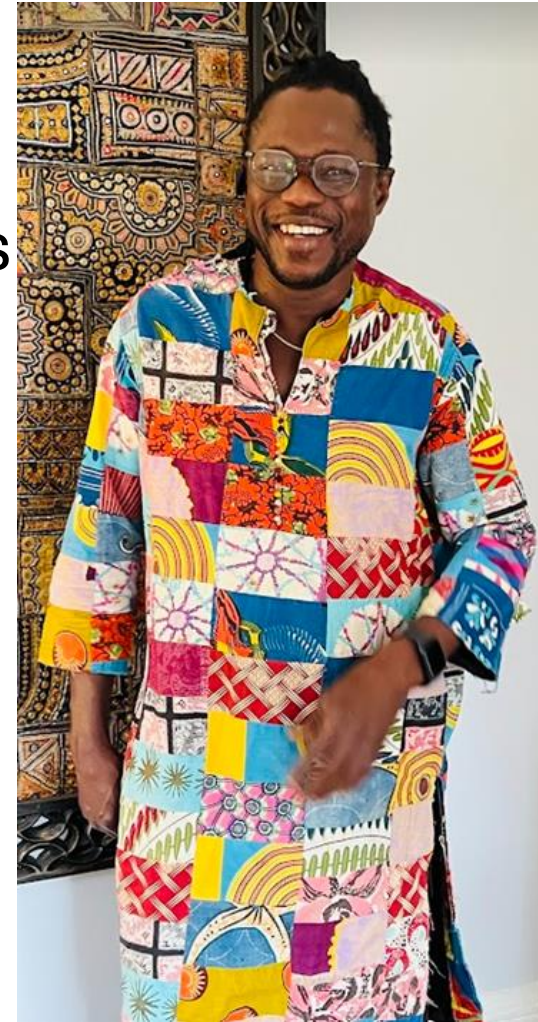

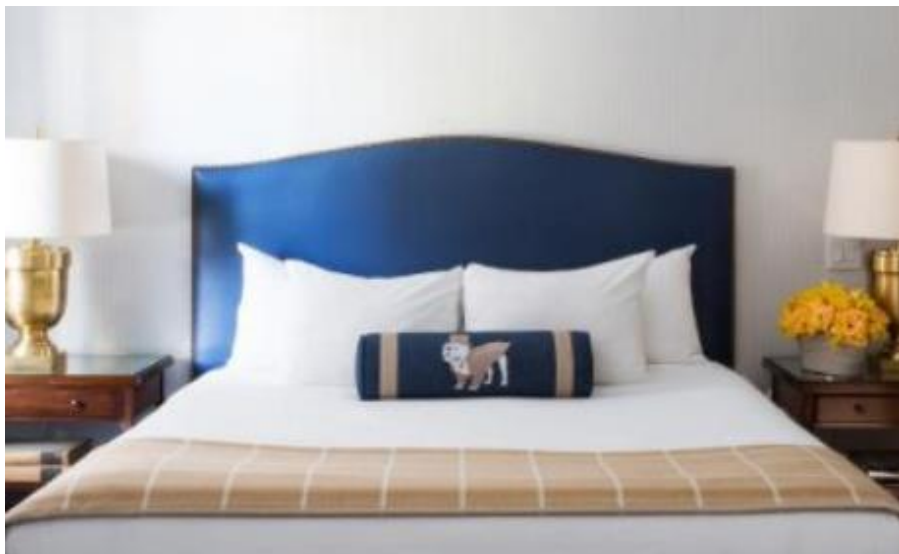
