




1st: directly flying to SZG / Salzburg


Essen, Germany September 5-7, 2025

I loved the trip to Senegal—it is truly a fascinating part of West Africa. Sherri made the trip beautifully memorable with a full and varied itinerary. We saw so much in the time we were there. We not only saw a number of sites in Senegal—but Sherri also arranged for us to meet some of its people—which I found particularly interesting.

We were based in the lovely town of Somone (with its relaxed open-air markets and sandy streets). The town lies next to a gorgeous strip of ocean beach with small hotels offering a West African and French flair.

We visited the renowned bird sanctuary in Somone which is set in a tranquil mangrove area next to the ocean.

We also went to Dakar (about an hour away) and took the ferry to the UNESCO site of Goree Island. It is filled with history, museums, art and emotion. It is not to be missed.

The Bandia Reserve is surprisingly close by—yet it is home to a wide selection of animals from giraffes to rhinos, zebras, antelope, etc plus some mischievous monkeys!

The landscape is interesting, too—with its baobab trees.

I loved the trip!










Hanoi
